Ultrasound of Shoulders and Knees

Not all shoulder and knee US are claimable. Try to get as much clinical history from the patient to ascertain whether it's claimable before the patients appointment.

Shoulders

Medicare benefits are **Claimable** for these indications:

- Evaluation of injury to tendon, muscle or muscle/tendon junction.
- Rotator cuff tear/calcification/tendinosis. (biceps, subscapular, supraspinatus, infraspinatus)
- Biceps Subluxation
- Capsulitis and bursitis (frozen shoulder)
- Evaluation of mass including ganglion
- ♦ Occult fracture
- Acromioclavicular joint pathology

Medicare benefits are **NOT Claimable** for these indications:

Including non-specific shoulder pain alone

Knees

Medicare benefits are Claimable for these indications:

- ◆ Abnormality of tendons or bursae about the knee
- Meniscal cyst, popliteal cyst, mass or psedomass
- Nerve entrapment, nerve or nerve sheath tumour
- injury of collateral ligaments (bakers cyst)

Medicare benefits are **NOT Claimable** for these indications:

- Knee pain
- Other conditions including meniscal and cruciate ligament tears
- Assesment of chodral surfaces
